"We do not learn from experience; we learn from reflecting on experience." John Dewy

An important part of the learning process is reflecting upon what has been learned and how it has contributed to an individual's development. Reflection is a central feature of education and serves the function of solidifying the connection between what a student has experienced and the meaning and learning that they derived from that experience.

Reflection is not a superficial process of introspection. Rather, it is an evidence-based, integrative, analytical, capacity-building process that serves to generate, deepen, critique, and document learning.

The development of reflective skills is central to students' academic and personal development in any class. The ability to reflect on one's learning is complex and time consuming when done well, but it is worth it because without giving a student time to reflect on an experience and share their reflections with educators, we cannot be certain of what learning occurred or what meaning the student gathered from the experience.

Reflecting is a learned skill. Many students are unfamiliar with the process. Students benefit from the guidance provided by an educator. Without support, reflections may be limited to descriptive accounts of an experience rather than "meaning making." Teachers can support students with questions or prompts that ensure their reflection is focused on the learning outcomes and personal development that the students have undergone.

The assessment practices used by teachers are very important as they help educators determine the student's level of growth, development and acquisition of knowledge and skills. However, only through student-led self-reflection can we be certain that learning has occurred and the learning has had a meaningful impact on the student. *Championing Students and Their Learning*
