Think about that argument you had with a loved one or the insult that is never forgotten. It is not your mind that remembers the argument, insult, or putdown; it is not the mind that remembers failure or lack of success; it is your heart that remembers. When you hear people speak of their pain, their loss; when you hear their lack of confidence and motivation, you are listening to their heart. Our hearts are in complete command of our thoughts. The mind is just a powerful passenger.

As teachers, parents, and friends, we do ourselves and others a disservice when we speak to the mind and not the heart. Speak to the heart by operating differently.
