



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT GRAD DINNER AND DANCE

The formal Grad Dinner and Dance celebration is held at the Pan Pacific Hotel in downtown Vancouver. Grads must bring their ticket and student ID to enter. Those grads who will also be attending the Dry After Grad party have transportation for the evening already arranged for them. They must be at the school promptly by 4:30 p.m. where they will sign in and board the luxury buses to take to the hotel. Following the Dinner/Dance, these grads have the same luxury buses ready to take them back to school for the Dry After Grad party.

Those grads who are making their own way to the hotel should leave Richmond no later than 4:45 p.m. as rush hour traffic is typically very congested at this time of day and you don't want to be late!

- The remainder of the evening will be dancing to 11:00 when grads board the bus to head back to Burnett for the Dry After Grad celebration.
