- * How can I find a way to serve others that will make a positive difference in their lives in difficult times?

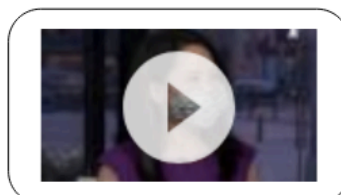
Directions:

1. Think about doing something for others. Find a way to serve others around you—a family member, friends, a neighbour or people in your community (e.g., nurses, doctors, fire fighters, grocery store employees, elders in a care home) that respects the health & safety of all involved (e.g., no contact, social distancing).
2. Invest 5-10 hours on your project (It should be important, meet a need, & make a positive difference).
3. Carry out your plan (do it) and document your progress (add documentation to myBlueprint).
4. Document your project on myBlueprint.

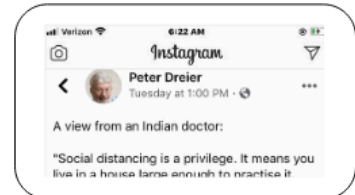
Here are some different ways to document:
