For the young, old and those in between, humility is the key to continuous learning. Humility allows us to recognize that we don’t know everything and that what we do know, does not necessarily give us wisdom. Instead, humility encourages us to recognize our biases and seek out additional sources of wisdom that we may lack.

Humility is not about knocking people down and/or dismissing their opinions. Humility is not thinking less of yourself but thinking of yourself less.
