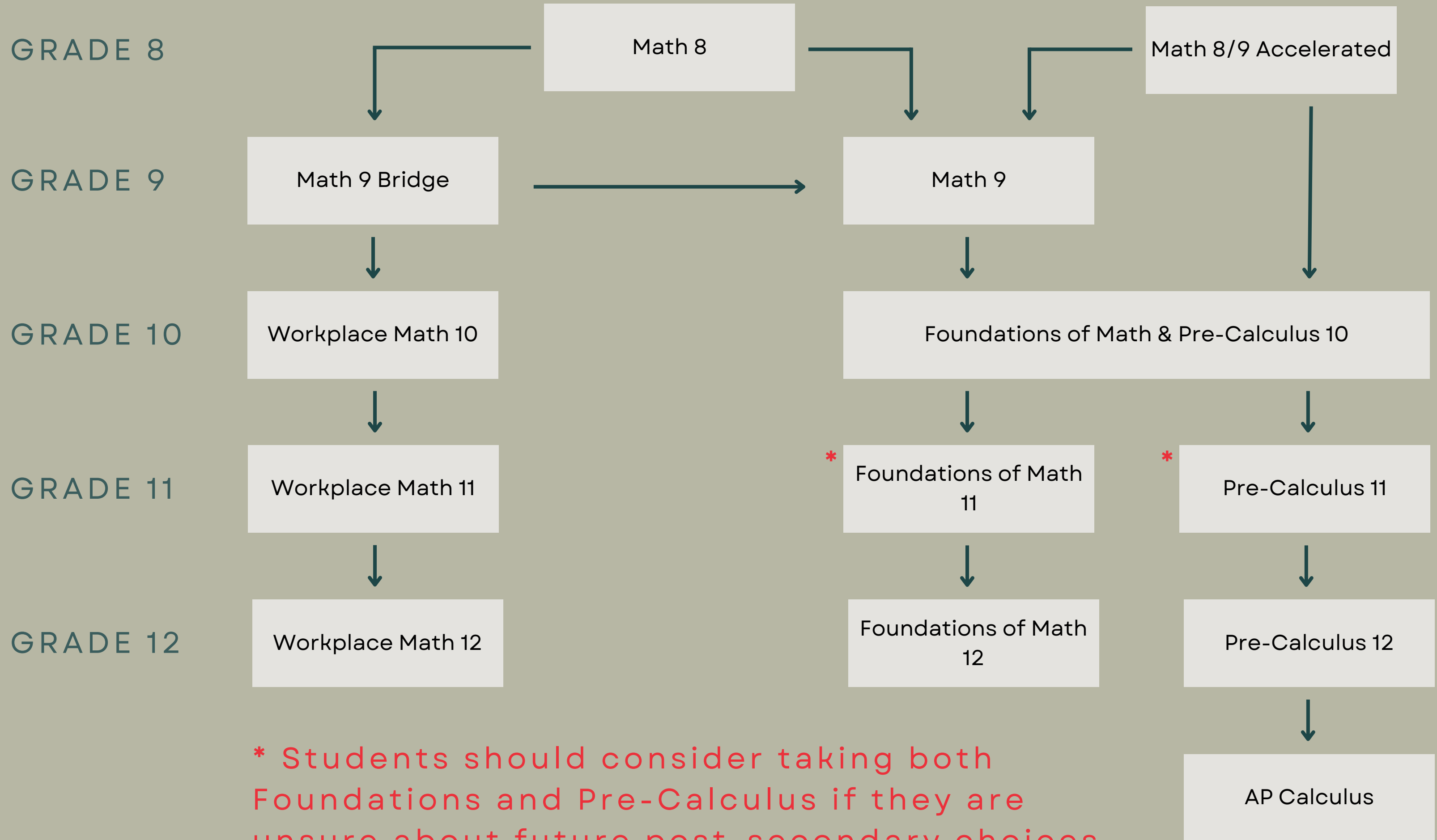

Math Pathways





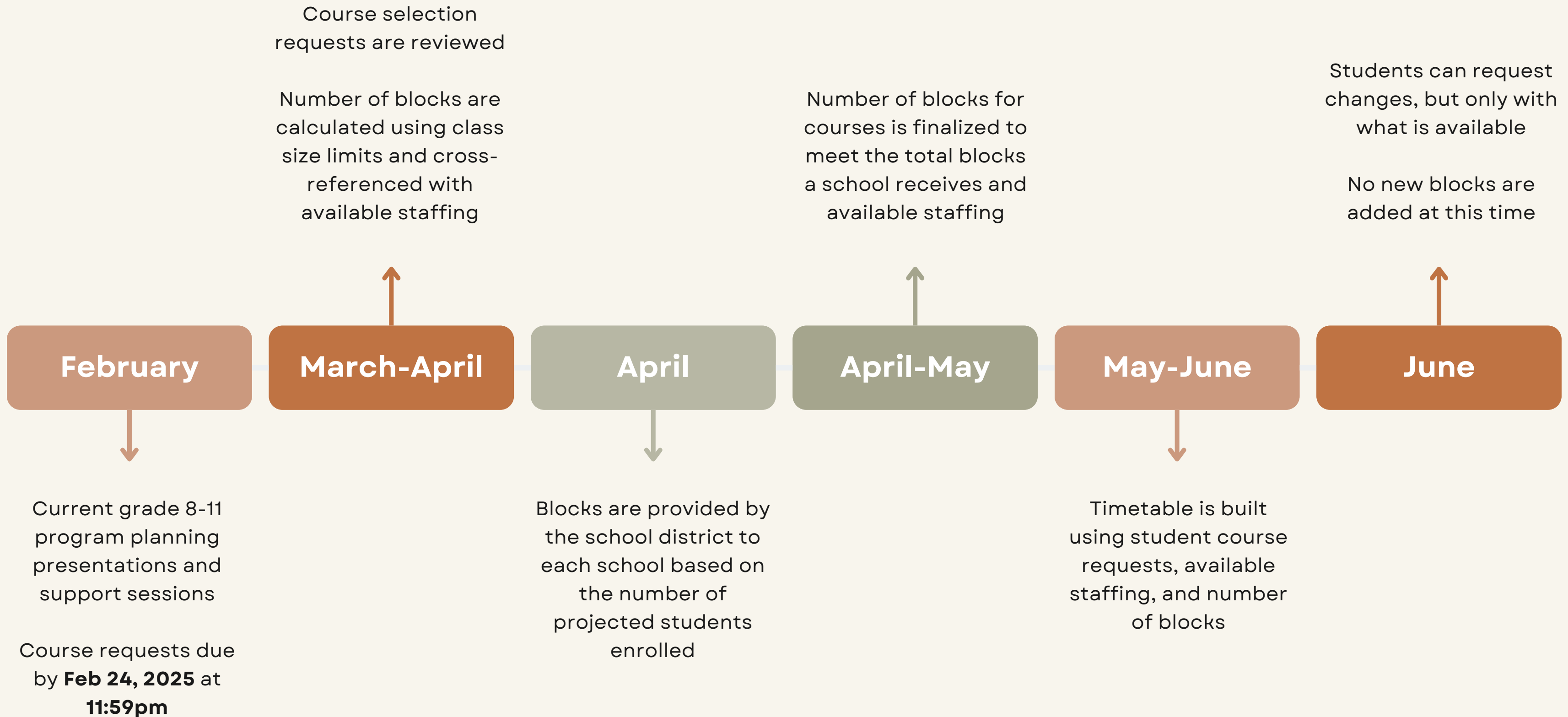

What Does This Mean?

The timetable is built based on what students request **NOW**. Requests after the due date may not be possible as the timetable is already built.

Take the time **NOW** to have your child research courses, talk to teachers, talk to their counsellor, talk to the career advisor, and look at prospective post-secondary options and requirements.

Include alternative courses! We cannot guarantee students will get their first choice. A well-built timetable can only satisfy approximately 80% of all student requests.

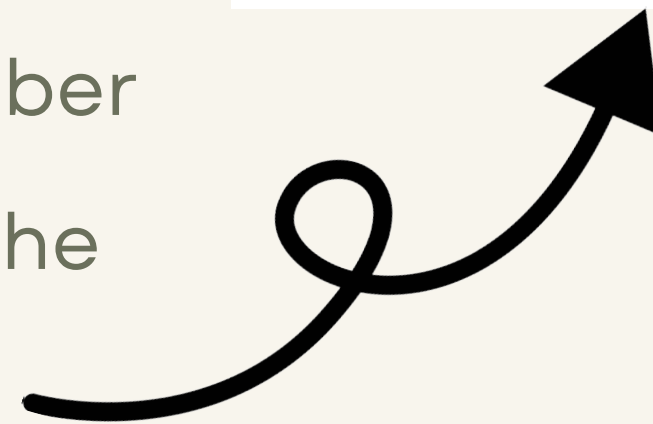
