

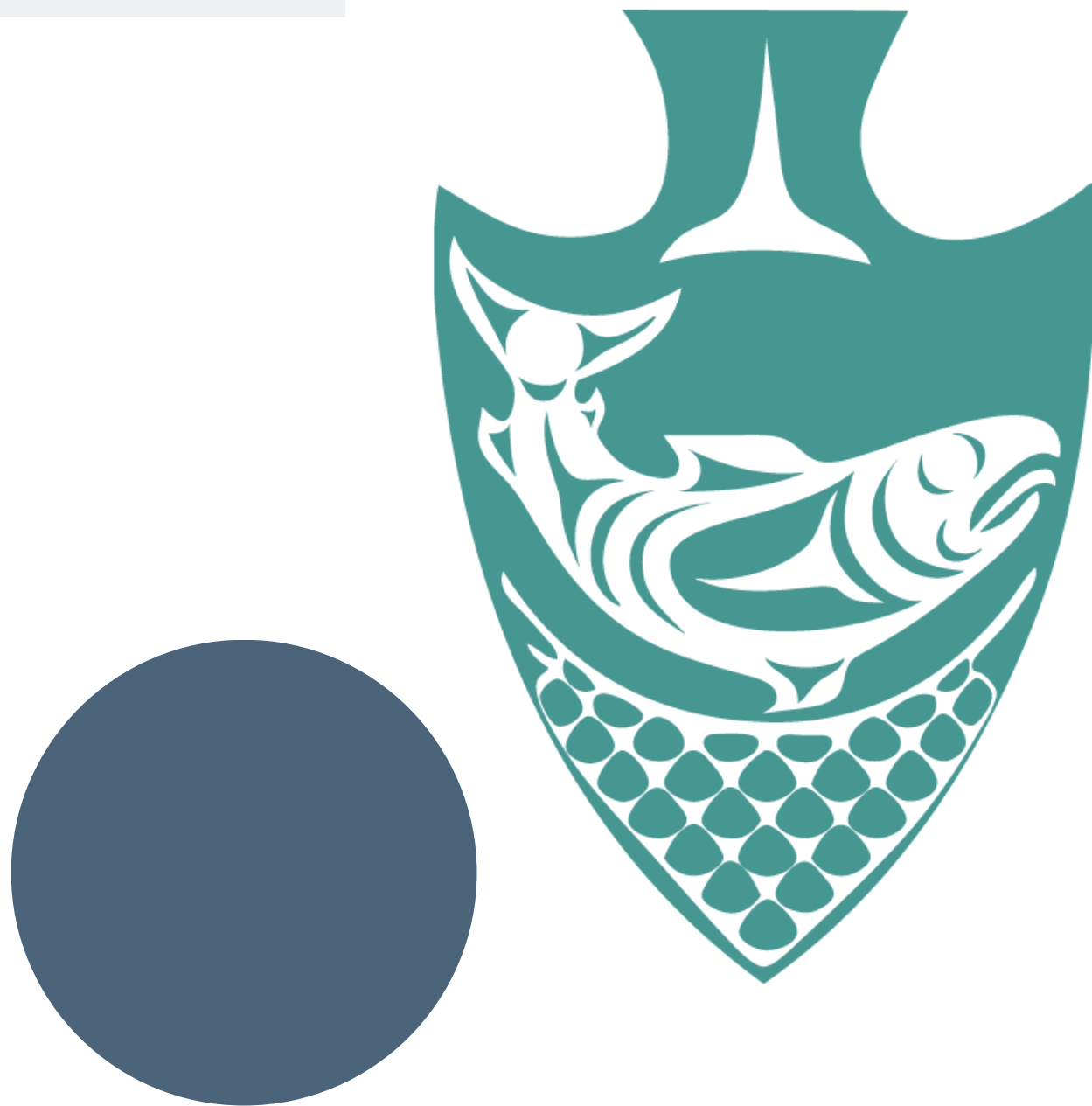

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2025 DURING PLT

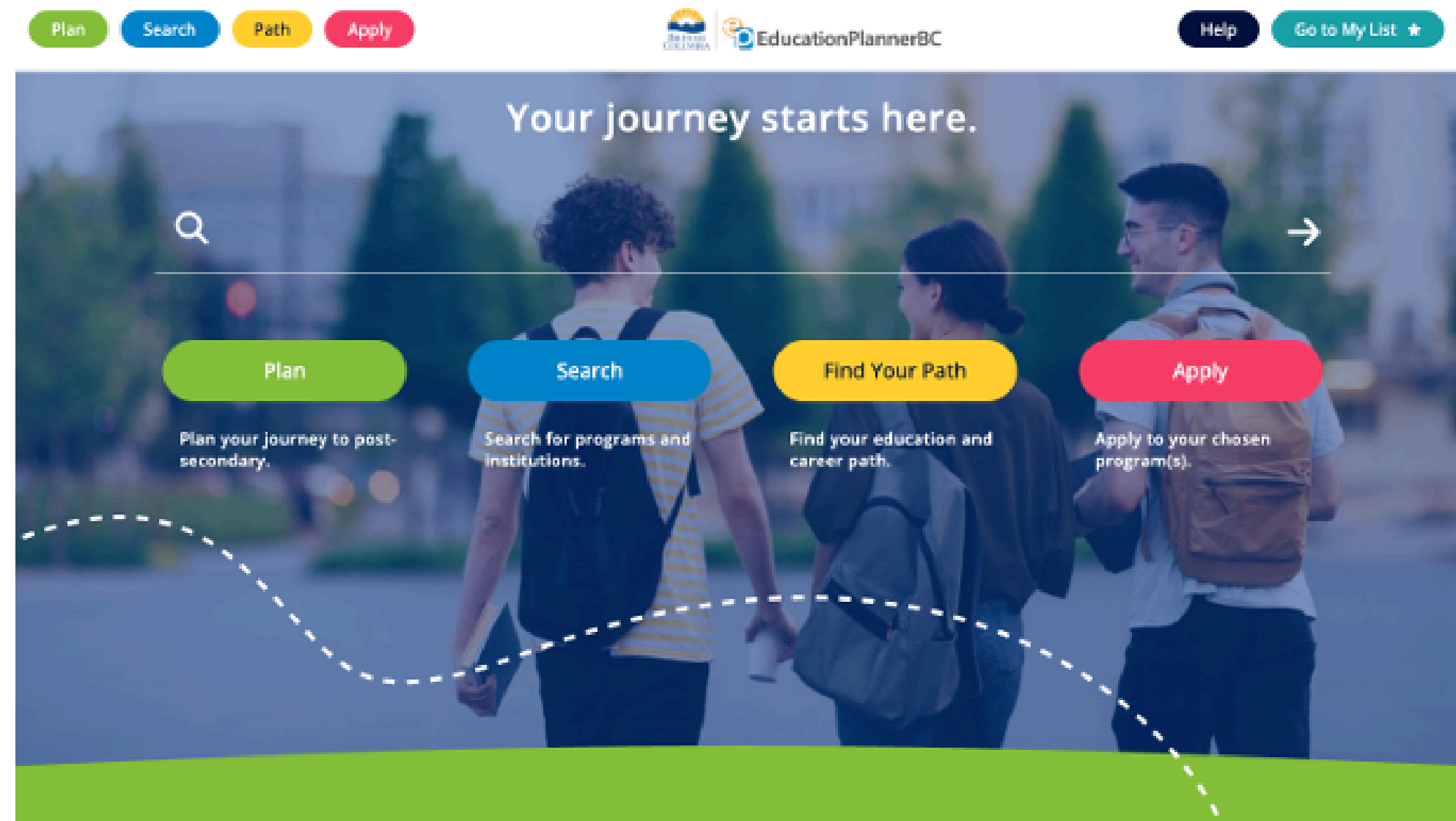

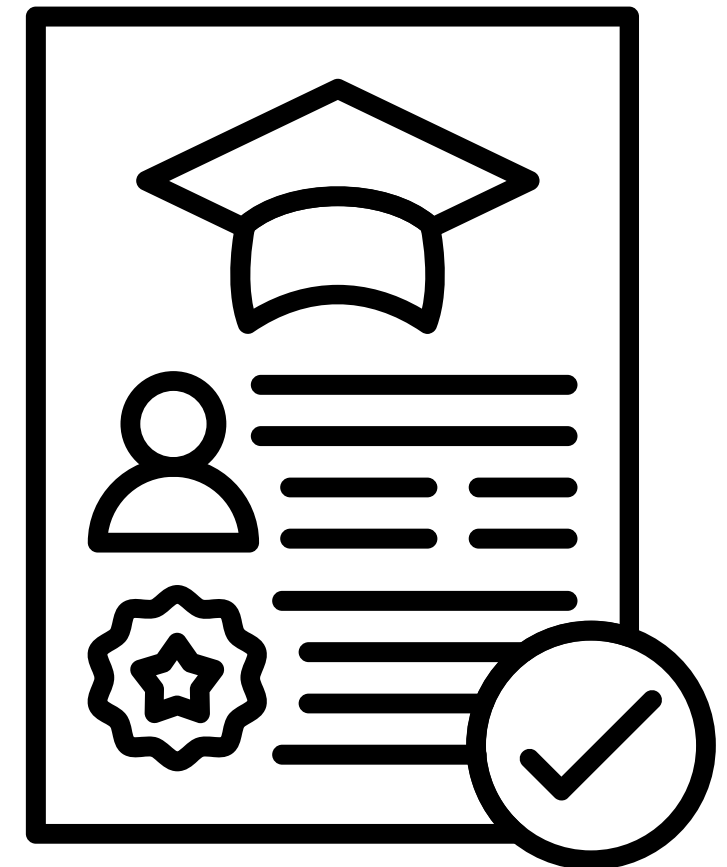

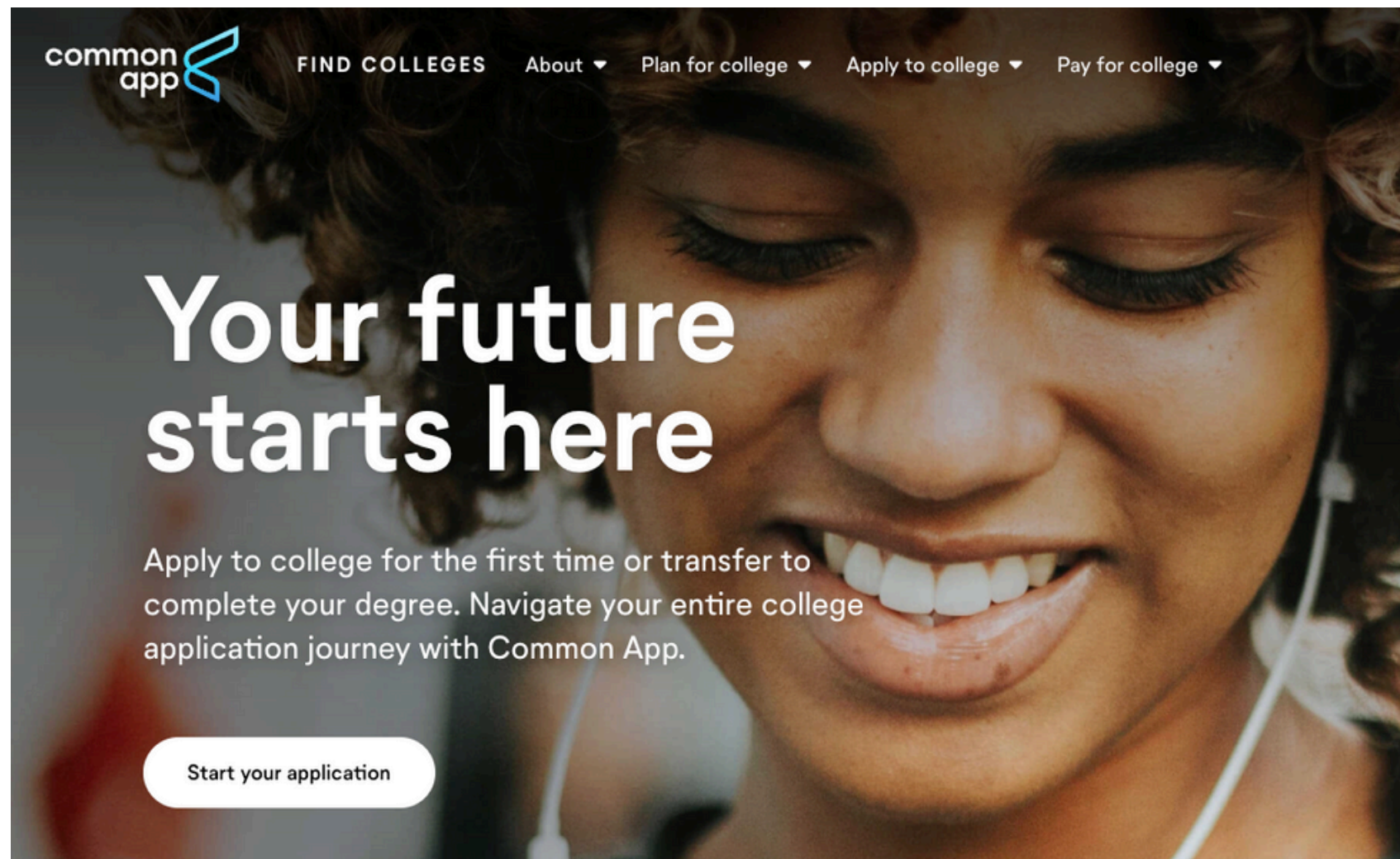
